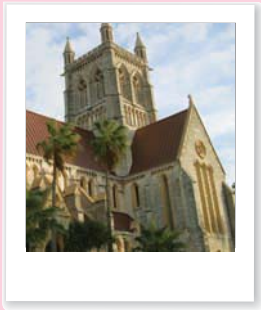

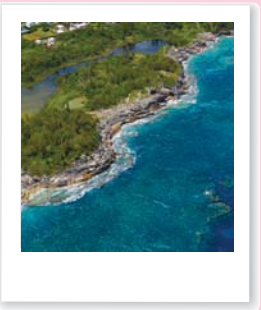

ECO TOURISM: bird watching, nature trails & tours

Birder watchers and Naturalists will find a wealth of 850 acres of trails, parks, beaches and nature reserves. The best months for birders are from September-April.

Parks & Nature Trails	Brief Description
Bermuda Railway Trail Islandwide	21 miles in total. Provides a scenic and interesting route from East to West. A well maintained trail used by walkers, joggers and birders alike.
Somerset Long Bay Area Road, Sandys	Three protected lots make up this area; the SLB West Nature Reserve, SLB National Park and SLB East Nature Reserve combine to make 10 acres. The eastern reserve is a closed bird sanctuary; the centre park is a wonderful beach and picnic area; the western reserve, purchased through a public fundraising campaign, is also open to the public and consists of a bird hide with interpretative signage coming soon.
Springfield & Gilbert Nature Reserve Road, Sandys	5 acres. This unspoiled woodland is an excellent spot for bird watching with walking paths just off the main road in Somerset Village and leads to the Railway Trail. Adjacent to the reserve is Springfield, an architectural treasure begun in the 1740s which is an example of plantation-style Bermudian architecture.
Heydon Trust Ely's Harbour, Sandys	22 acres. Has trails, picnic area and a chapel dating from 1616. Breathtaking views of the Great Sound.
Hog Bay Park Middle Road, Sandys	38 acres. This park includes well-maintained hiking trails, farming plots and wooded hillsides with native and endemic vegetation. It also offers a quiet, secluded coastal cove at low tide.
Warwick Pond Middle Road, Warwick	This 9-acre nature reserve is the second largest freshwater pond in Bermuda and is an important sanctuary for resident and migratory waterfowl. The eastern hillside forms an integral part of an extensive woodland belt that borders the entire length of the Warwick Railway Trail. The walking trail, with interpretative signage, will be expanded in 2009 to include the neighbouring Powell Estate.
Paget Marsh South Road, Paget	This lush and leafy nature reserve, jointly administered by the Bermuda National Trust and Bermuda Audubon Society, is a unique green space of 25 acres of original Bermuda. The peat marsh is covered with a cedar and palmetto forest; and has remained much the same since before the arrival of the first settlers. It is now accessible by a wooden board walk with interpretive signage. The pond and marsh are home to an array of wildlife, including many species of resident and migratory birds.
Admiralty House Park Spanish Point, Pembroke	16 acres. This park has well maintained walking trails, interesting sea caves, an enclosed calm water beach cove for swimming and excellent picnic grounds. Of special interest are the cliffs and caves which challenge the inquisitive explorer.
The Arboretum Middle Road, Devonshire	19 acres. Close to the City of Hamilton. Offers a variety of picnic areas. Large expanse of open space which includes several tree and palm collections. Used greatly by cross country runners and fitness enthusiasts.
Devonshire Marsh Vesey Street, Devonshire	36 acres. Some of Bermuda's last endemic vegetation makes it a haven for birds and wildlife. No footpaths penetrating the marsh.
Spittal Pond Nature Reserve South Road, Smith's Parish	34 acres. The largest and most accessible nature reserve. Excellent trails and bird watching observation points. Large variety of bird life during Spring and Fall migrations.
Blue Hole Park Hamilton Parish	Idwal Hughes Nature Reserve / Walsingham Trust Nature Reserve together make up the Walsingham nature reserve area a.k.a. Tom Moore's Jungle. 12 acres. The reserve's rugged limestone landscape sits on the island's oldest geological formation. It is extremely diverse and supports many natural habitats, including caves, sinkholes, marine ponds, mangroves, coastline and woodlands. As a result there are many rare and endangered plant and animal species, both native and endemic to Bermuda.
Ferry Point Park Ferry Reach Road, St. George's	63 acres. Very rural open space that offers picnicking, sheltered swimming, fishing and walking trails. The parkland surrounds the Martello Tower, Ferry Island Fort, a magazine, an historic cemetery, a small lake and a lime kiln. Seasonal camping is permitted by special permit only.
